

8th Meeting of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC)

The 8th meeting of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) was held on 20th July 2015 in New Delhi. Mr. S. Ramadorai, Chairman, NSDA, chaired the meeting.

Agenda Item No. 1: Approval of Minutes of the 7th Meeting of NSQC

There were no further comments on the minutes of the 7th NSQC Meeting and the same were treated as approved.

Agenda Item No. 2: Action Taken Report

DG, NSDA provided an update on the action taken by NSDA since the last NSQC Meeting held on 18th June 2015 and they are listed as under:

2.1 Sub-Committee for Accreditation Norms for Training Providers:

DG, NSDA informed that, the meeting of the sub-committee for Accreditation Norms was held on 25th June 2015 at the NSDA office. Based on the discussions during the meeting, the sub-committee has prepared a draft report on norms for accrediting training providers, which was submitted to DG, NSDA on 29th June, 2015. The report has been circulated for comments and final report would be presented in the 10th NSQC meeting. **(Action: NSDA)**

2.2 Formation of a Sub-Committee for RPL Guidelines:

DG, NSDA informed that the meeting of the sub-committee on RPL was held on 27th May 2015, with the aim to deliberate upon the draft guidelines that were shared with the sub-committee members. A draft report on RPL was prepared by the sub-committee and was submitted to the DG, NSDA on 29th June 2015. The report has been circulated for comments and final report would be submitted in the 10th NSQC meeting. **(Action: NSDA)**

2.3 Process of Curriculum Development and Involvement of Subject Matter Experts:

DG, NSDA informed the Committee that a meeting would be organised soon between NSDC and NSDA, to understand the process of curriculum alignment, in which NSDC would explain the process of aligning curriculum with NOSs/QPs. **(Action: NSDA and NSDC)**

2.4 Meeting regarding mapping of NCVT Qualifications to NOSs and QPs

It was informed that NSDA had organised a meeting on 10th July 2015 (as an action with respect to Minutes under Agenda Item 4 of the 7th NSQC meeting) with representatives from NSDC, NCVT in order to discuss whether NCVT qualifications should be mapped to QPs or not. During the meeting, while NSDC suggested that NCVT qualifications should be mapped to QPs, DGT was of the view that qualifications should be mapped against NOSs and partial mapping with QPs. Given that NCVT has already mapped their qualifications with NOSs and partially with QPs, the Committee approved the qualifications of NCVT presented in the last NSQC meeting. **(Action: NCVT)**

2.5 Procedure for Validating QPs

DG, NSDA informed that in the last NSQC meeting, SSCs were requested to provide a detailed process manual stating the exact procedure that is adopted while validating QPs. This should clearly indicate how these industries are chosen, their classification into small, medium and large and the definition adopted by these SSCs for such classification (Minutes under Agenda Item 5.3.1 of the 7th NSQC meeting). Response is still awaited from SSCs.

DG, NSDA emphasized that SSCs should ensure true industry representation by considering sectoral composition and geographical/regional distribution for validating their QPs. Further, it was pointed out that the validation of QPs by only 30 industry players (10 Large, 10 Medium and 10 Small) may not be an appropriate sample size in case of sectors where number of industries is very large. In addition, industry representation must be able to represent the organised as well as the unorganized sector. Hence, it is important to redefine the current norms of industry validations as adopted by SSCs. **(Action: NSDC, SSCs)**

2.6 Sector-wise Workshops with Industry Representatives

DG, NSDA informed that sector-wise workshops would be held between the NSDA and the industry representatives involved in validation of QPs, in order to understand the process of validation in a better manner (Minutes under Agenda Item 5.3.2 of the 7th NSQC meeting). The same would be organised soon. **(Action: NSDA, SSCs)**

2.7 Meeting with Rubber and Leather SSC

DG, NSDA informed that a separate meeting would be held between NSDA and representatives from Rubber and Leather SSCs (Minutes under Agenda Item 5.4 of the 7th NSQC meeting) in order to discuss if the QPs being developed by the concerned SSCs could be reviewed in order to increase the employability of the candidates being trained by them. As it was pointed out that some of the QPs are too narrow and persons trained with such QPs might find difficulty in getting jobs in the informal sector where multiple job roles is handled by single person. Workshop to discuss these issues would be organised soon. **(Action: NSDA, Leather/Rubber SSCs)**

Agenda Item No. 3: NSDA's update on NSQF related activities

3.1 NSQF Workshop in Tamil Nadu and West Bengal

DG, NSDA updated the Committee regarding NSQF workshops in the States of Tamil Nadu and West Bengal. The States have been advised to form an internal working group at the State level that would coordinate with NSDA in identifying different qualifications recognized by the State Government and present them in the form of a Qualification File for approval by the NSQC for making these qualifications NSQF compliant.

3.2 Submission of Qualification Files as per Timeline

Out of the 1319 QPs developed so far, 447 Qualification Files have been approved by the NSQC till 7th NSQC Meeting. The remaining 872 Files were to be reviewed. A total of 852 Q Files were received as on 8th July 2015, out of which 522 were tabled before the NSQC.

3.3 Quality Assurance Framework

The Overview Manual of the Quality Assurance Framework has been prepared that gives an insight into the entire proposed QA process to address the need for Quality Assurance norms for vocational education. It has also been circulated to all NSQC members for their comments and the same was presented before the members at the 7th NSQC meeting held on 18th June 2015 (Minutes under Agenda Item 7 of the 7th NSQC meeting). So far, comments have been received from NIOS and NSDC. Comments from the other NSQC members are awaited.

The manual has been circulated for comments. Once comments are received, the final report would be placed before the 10th NSQC meeting for approval.
(Action: NSDA)

Agenda Item No. 4: Approval of Qualification Files for NCVT Qualifications

Representative from DDGT presented 24 Qualifications under NCVT for approval by NSQC and same were approved. Details of these qualifications are at **Annexure II**.

Agenda Item No. 5: Approval of Qualification Files (QFs) by various SSCs

The Committee was informed that 852 QFs have been submitted to the NSDA. Out of these, 522 QFs were presented before the NSQC and 512 were approved. The number of QFs approved for every sector is as under:

Some of the recommendations of the Committee are as under:

5.1 Representative from NSDC mentioned that there is a provision for review of QPs after every two years. In this context, few SSCs present during the meeting brought to light that their QPs are in the process of review. In this regard, the Committee recommended that a critical aspect of review should be the establishment of evidence of need of QPs. The SSCs agreed to consider this aspect as one of the critical parameters while reviewing the QPs. **(Action: SSCs and NSDC)**

5.2 The Committee advised the Mining SSC to consult Director General, Mines to discuss the notional hours of the courses on Mining sector. **(Action: Mining SSC)**

5.3 The Qualification File for Domestic Workers was approved by the Committee. However, the Committee recommended that it should be vetted and adopted by the concerned Sector Skill Council, once it is formally created.

Agenda Item No. 6: Any other matter with the approval of the Chair

6.1 Meeting to be organized on RPL

Information on RPL in the Qualification File has not been presented adequately and the same needs to be more specific and elaborate. In this regard, the Chairman emphasized that RPL strategy should be framed taking into account ground realities and challenges in RPL processes.

6.2 Skill Training Curriculum

DG, NSDA informed the Committee that the Hon'ble Minister, MSDE has stressed upon the consistency in quality of curriculum being adopted during skill training. The

importance of curriculum becomes all the more critical to ensure quality training under the flagship scheme of PMKVY. In this regard the Committee recommended that the SSCs need to ensure the quality of curriculum being adopted by training Providers. **(Action: SSCs)**

6.3 Notional Hours of Skill Training

DG, NSDA highlighted that the rationale of fixing notional hours for every QP should be reviewed by every SSC on the basis of the curriculum being adopted in training candidates against these QPs. Notional Hours shown in the Qualification Files needs to be reviewed and rationalized taking curriculum into consideration. This needs to be addressed within a period of three months, by 20th October 2015. The Chairman also highlighted that the justification for every QP should be validated by the number of candidates getting placed in the right job with right wages. **(Action: SSCs)**

Meeting ended with vote of thanks by the Chair.
