ORDER

Subject: Extension of Transition Period for the existing Awarding Bodies (AB) seeking NCVET recognition- Reg

1. Whereas the Guidelines for 'Recognition and Regulation of Awarding Bodies' were launched on 27th October, 2020 and a transition period of one-year w.e.f 27th Oct, 2020 was provided to all existing Awarding Bodies vide NCVET Office Order number 22003/4/2020/NCVET dated 28/10/20 for implementation of these NCVET Guidelines. Also, all such bodies were given six months' time to apply for the NCVET recognition before the expiry of transition period as per the procedure prescribed in the above-mentioned guidelines, i.e. by 27th April, 2021, and
2. Whereas due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and lockdown imposed by the Government, a number of requests were received from the existing Awarding Bodies and Assessment Agencies to extend the last date of submission of the application for NCVET recognition. Considering the unprecedented situation, the competent authority extended date of submission of the applications for award of recognition by one-month i.e till 27th May, 2021 vide Order number 22003/4/2020/NCVET dated 30/04/2021, and
3. Whereas till date, a total of 69 proposals for recognition as Awarding Bodies have been received by NCVET. The proposals submitted by the Awarding Bodies are at various stages of screening, evaluation and review. It has been observed that majority of the submitted proposals are incomplete in some aspects or are not entirely in line with the requirements of the recognition prescribed in the Guidelines of NCVET, and



4. Whereas, the observations regarding the same have been communicated to the concerned applicant bodies from time to time. However, the responses against these observations are still incomplete or awaited in many cases as the additional information/ clarifications submitted by the applicant bodies are also not complete and require further clarification/ information to be submitted by the applicant bodies. Some proposals which have completed and passed through the above process have undergone extensive scrutiny, evaluation, review and discussion at the levels of Directors and Executive members, and
5. Whereas, so far only 24 proposals are found to be complete after extensive scrutiny, evaluation and have been reviewed at the level of EMs. Out of these, 19 proposals which complied with the observations made by the Review Panel, were presented before the Sub-Committee constituted by the NCVET Council for the purpose of taking a final decision regarding their recognition. However, these applicants are yet to carry out the final revisions in their proposals as per the observations and suggestions made by the Sub-Committee.
6. Therefore, in view of the above, to facilitate continuity in the vocational education and trainings being carried out in the skill ecosystem and to complete the recognition process, the competent authority has approved the further extension of the transition period till 31st January, 2022, or till a final decision is taken by NCVET on these proposal for recognition, whichever is earlier, for the 45 existing Awarding Bodies, as per list enclosed at **Annexure**, who have submitted their applications for NCVET recognition, and which are at various stages of scrutiny, evaluation, review and final presentations before the Sub-Committee.
7. The order is effective from 27th October, 2021.




