**Corrigendum: Extension of Transition Period for the existing Awarding Bodies (AB) seeking NCVET recognition- Reg**

1. Reference to this Office Order 38004/01/2021/AB/ NCVET dated 10<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2021.

2. Following amendments may please be made in the said Office Order:-

a) **For Paragraph 3.**

"3. Whereas till date, a total of 69 proposals for recognition as Awarding Bodies have been received by NCVET. The proposals submitted by the Awarding Bodies are at various stages of screening, evaluation and review. It has been observed that majority of the submitted proposals are incomplete in some aspects or are not entirely in line with the requirements of the recognition prescribed in the Guidelines of NCVET, and"

b) **Read Paragraph 3 as.**

"3. Whereas till date, a total of 72 proposals for recognition as Awarding Bodies have been received by NCVET. The proposals submitted by the Awarding Bodies are at various stages of screening, evaluation and review. It has been observed that majority of the submitted proposals are incomplete in some aspects or are not entirely in line with the requirements of the recognition prescribed in the Guidelines of NCVET, and"

c) **For Paragraph 6.**

"6. Therefore, in view of the above, to facilitate continuity in the vocational education and trainings being carried out in the skill ecosystem and to complete the recognition process, the competent authority has approved the further extension of the transition period till 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2022, or till a final decision is taken by NCVET on these proposal for recognition, whichever is



earlier, for the 45 existing Awarding Bodies, as per list enclosed at **Annexure**, who have submitted their applications for NCVET recognition, and which are at various stages of scrutiny, evaluation, review and final presentations before the Sub-Committee”.

d) **Read Paragraph 6.**

“6. Therefore, in view of the above, to facilitate continuity in the vocational education and trainings being carried out in the skill ecosystem and to complete the recognition process, the competent authority has approved the further extension of the transition period till 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2022, or till a final decision is taken by NCVET on these proposal for recognition, whichever is earlier, for the 46 existing Awarding Bodies, as per list enclosed at **Annexure**, who have submitted their applications for NCVET recognition, and which are at various stages of scrutiny, evaluation, review and final presentations before the Sub-Committee”.

e) In Annexure, include **West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development (WBSCTVE&SD)** at Serial No 46.
