AGENDA ITEM No 04: In-Principle Approval to the Qualification- Commercial Vehicle Driver (LMO) of Logistics Sector Skill Council

5. NCVET had received a request for the urgent approval of training Commercial Vehicle Driver, Liquid Medical Oxygen (LMO) on 09 Jun 2021 stating that LMO drivers are critical in the Nation's fight against COVID.

6. This is a short term qualification of 217 hours which is pegged at level 4 and with the entry requirements as three years of driving experience on HMV vehicle. Approximately, 3000 HMV drivers will be mobilized both from ex defence category and the civilian category which are already employed by transporters. In this regards, LSC had received a recommendation letter from the Ministry of Commerce highlighting the

importance of skilling drivers to handle the LMO tankers mentioning the demand forecast and also had sought support from MSDE to take up this job role.

7. Considering the urgency of demand of the drivers for transporting Liquid Medical Oxygen especially in the light of the on-going pandemic situation in the country, NCVET had accorded 'In-principle' approval to the Qualification 'Commercial Vehicle Driver (LMO)' with a validity of one year.

The Qualification is placed before the Committee for ratification.

AGENDA ITEM No05: Development of Qualification in English, Hindi and other Indian Languages

8. The National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) is a competency-based framework that organises all Qualifications according to a series of levels of knowledge, skills and aptitude.

9. It is well known fact that English language has always been a barrier to entry into education, especially in the vocational education, higher and professional education. The Language divide has created a socio-economic divide and inequity based on languages, medium of education and access to it. The vernacular language is a medium of instructions in most of the developed countries like China, Germany, Israel, France, Japan, South Korea, and Russia etc. who have made significant advances in science, technology, innovation, business and economy.

10. The Hon'ble PM, in October 2020, has urged the promotion of Indian languages in Engineering & Medical Education etc. to eliminate the handicap faced by our youth for access to higher education. The New Education Policy 2020 also emphasises on the use of Indian Languages and Mother Tongue in education. Accordingly, the Ministry of Education has already accorded in principle approval for technical education in Indian languages in select engineering institutions/ selected branches from the Academic Year 2021-22.

11. The language barrier is even more pronounced in Vocational Education and Training where the trainees often come from the marginalised sections of society for whom English becomes even a bigger barrier. To ensure inclusivity, it is therefore essential for NCVET as an overarching National Regulator to promote the widespread use of Indian Language in imparting Vocational Education and Training.

12. The following line of actions was therefore proposed before the 3rd NCVET Council meeting held on 15.06.2021: -

- (a) The Awarding/ Submitting Bodies to develop the qualification in English and Hindi as per the NSQF alignment process and submit the same for approval of NSQC.
- (b) The Awarding/ Submitting Bodies shall also ensure the availability of these qualifications, and related curricula, training resources in the Hindi

and other Indian Language of the State where the Vocational Education and Training courses are envisioned to be conducted.

(c) For adoption of these Qualifications by any other Awarding Bodies for conducting the training in any part of the country, such adopting Awarding Bodies may be mandated to convert the Qualifications in the Indian Language of the State concerned where the adopted Qualifications are intended to be used for Vocational Education and Training.

(d) The Awarding/Submitting Bodies may be given a timeline of six months to one year to convert the content of all the existing NSQF aligned Qualifications in Hindi and Indian Languages as per its applicability. There is no change in the qualification except the next-review-date, which is proposed to be of three years from the date of approval of qualification.

13. The NCVET Council has approved the proposal.

The matter is placed before the Committee for ratification by NSQC as well.

AGENDA ITEM No 06: Delegation of power to the Chairperson, NCVET w.r.t. decision on qualification related matters in emergent situation

14. The NSQF alignment of qualification/s which is a mandate of NCVET is operationalized through National Skills Qualification Committee and presently, NSQC is conducted every month, and qualifications received two months in advance and complete in all respect are taken up for NSQC approval. However, there are certain inevitable instances wherein the qualifications need immediate approval owing to emergency scenarios like pandemic, hurricanes, earthquake, other emergencies, mishap in mining etc. or disapproval owing to certain court decisions / legal issues.

15. In order to deal with unforeseen situations and take immediate action in matters which are considered urgent and important in the national/ public interest, it is proposed that the Chairperson, NCVET be delegated the power to approve the Q-Files and subsequently be brought before the NSQC for ratification.

16. This matter was placed before the NCVET Council meeting dated 15.06.2021 and has already been approved by the Council.

The matter is placed before the Committee for ratification by NSQC as well.
