**2.1. Decisions taken in the 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting of NSQC**

**3. AGENDA ITEM 03: Approval of one (01) Qualification (IT -ITeS Sector) received from Ganpat University- ratification there of**

- 3.1 Ganpat University had applied for seeking recognition as an Awarding Body (dual category) by NCVET. As per the prescribed norms, any entity seeking recognition as an awarding body has to showcase its capability to develop new qualification and get it aligned and approved as per prescribed NSQF norms. Accordingly, the Applicant

20 qualifications for NSQF alignment and approval. The detailed scrutiny of the qualifications is currently under progress. However, to meet the mandated requirement for signing the agreement, one qualification from IT-ITeS Sector namely, “Associate Data Analyst” (future skills) at NSQF Level 5 has been processed as per the NSQF norms and the qualification was approved on file to complete the process for signing of agreement. **4. AGENDA ITEM 04: Operationalisation of Skill India Digital (SID) and registration on SID by Awarding Bodies, Assessment Agencies**

4.1 Skill India Digital (SID) has been envisioned, developed, and implemented as the Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI) for skilling, education, employment and entrepreneurship in India. It is a comprehensive digital platform which provides every Learner with access to quality skill development, relevant opportunities and entrepreneurial support.

**4.2 Transition of Skill India Portal (SIP) to Skill India Digital (SID):**

4.2.1 Skill India Portal (SIP) has undergone a transformation and now subsumed into Skill India Digital (SID) making the platform more comprehensive and digitally advanced for skill development, offering a wide array of features to empower learners with following salient features:

- a) Comprehensive Skill Development: Feature all NSQF aligned and approved Qualifications, industry-relevant skill courses, job opportunities, and entrepreneurship support, ensuring comprehensive skill development.
- b) Information Gateway: Serves as a central information hub for all government skilling and entrepreneurship initiatives, facilitating easy access to all Learners seeking career advancement and lifelong learning.
- c) Aadhaar/AI-based Facial Authentication: Ensuring secure access and verification.
- d) AI based recommendations: Offering personalized learning paths, courses, skill centers and jobs.
- e) Citizen-Centric Approach: Ensuring inclusivity by supporting multiple Indian languages.
- f) GIS-enabled Maps to locate and access centers and navigate.
- g) Customized User Dashboard to curate journey and track progress.
- h) Auto-Generate Certificate, Feedback.

**4.3. Facilitating onboarding of NCVET recognized Awarding Bodies including their affiliated Training Partners/Centers and recognized Assessment Agencies in the VET & Skilling Ecosystem:**

4.3.1. NSDC would make a **separate section on the dashboard of the SID for NCVET**. All NCVET recognized Awarding Bodies and Assessment Agencies would be required to register on SID for training assessment and certification through NCVET by creating a simplified process for registration on SID at **no cost basis**. All recognized awarding bodies and assessment agencies would mandatorily register



on the SID portal which will be verified and approved online by the NCVET for the initial registration.

- 4.3.2. All recognized, awarding bodies and assessment agencies would thus be able to form training batches, conduct the training as per minimum standards prescribed for training through their affiliated training centers and allocate the batch for assessment to the onboarded assessment agencies and ensure certification of successfully assessed learners as is being done hitherto fore on the SIP.

**5. AGENDA ITEM 05: Modification in the Defence Qualification- 'Foreign Language Interpreter by Army Education Corps (AEC) approved in 31<sup>st</sup> NSQC held on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2023**

- 5.1 The qualification **Foreign Language Interpreter** submitted by Army Education Corps was approved in the 31<sup>st</sup> NSQC with the following details:

- 5.2 The minimum eligibility criteria for soldiers, getting enrolled in the Army Education Corps (AEC) is graduation in any field (B.SC IT/ BE/ B.Tech BA/ BCA/ M.Sc/MA/MCA/). There is also provision wherein soldiers from other branches of the Armed Forces are given access to aspirational qualifications like Foreign Language Interpreter in AEC. In the latter case, they may not be graduate. However, to meet the operational requirement as also to align with the NCrf norms, any soldier who is 12<sup>th</sup> pass having good communication skills in English and Hindi and has five years' experience are also given opportunity to appear in the Language Aptitude test (LAT) to determine a learner's aptitude prior to commencing the training. To be eligible for training as a Foreign Language Interpreter, soldier has to pass the LAT (except those from Intelligence and Education Corps).

- 5.3 Accordingly, the Awarding Body (AEC) has now revised the entry criteria and NSQF level have submitted before the committee. The details are as below:

\*All 59 qualifications of National Academy of RUDSETI have since expired in July 2023. They have neither been revised nor rationalized. No training inputs have been provided by the AB, RUDSETI(NAR) as on date. All qualifications are therefore are deemed inactive and is recommended to be archived.

6.4 It is proposed that all recognized ABs be given a definite timeline to complete rationalization of their existing NSQF aligned and approved qualifications to ensure its seamless integration and alignment with NCrf and NSQF for ease of implementation in various government schemes like PMKVY, DDUGKY, NULM etc. The Awarding Bodies must submit their remaining NSQF aligned and approved qualifications to NCVET duly rationalised, by 20<sup>th</sup> Oct 2023 failing which the process of archival of the unrationalized qualifications will be initiated.

6.5 Further, as all the CITS and CTS qualifications of DGT have also been restructured in the form of NOS and PCs, DGT is also advised to rationalize their NOS in the multiples of 30 hours to ensure smooth and ease of adoption of the NOS in the VET & skilling ecosystem.

## **7. AGENDA ITEM 07: NSQF alignment and approval of qualifications (Upskilling NOS) for PM Vishwakarma scheme launched on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2023**

7.1 In the 31<sup>st</sup> NSQC meeting, the Committee had accorded 'In-principle' approval to the 28 qualifications (Upskilling NOS) in 18 trades under PM Vishwakarma Scheme. The Committee had also approved the methodology deployed for the NSQF alignment of the PM Vishwakarma qualifications.

7.2 Further, the Committee advised that as these qualifications are being given approval for a special project hence a separate section needs to be created on NQR for "PM Vishwakarma Scheme Qualifications". Accordingly, a separate section has been created for "PM Vishwakarma Scheme Qualifications" on NQR and the details of all 25

qualifications including the Model Curriculum have been uploaded on the NQR. A summary of the qualifications is enclosed as **Annexure I**.

7.3 The PM Vishwakarma Scheme has been launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2023 to improve the quality as well as the reach of the products and services of traditional artisans and craftspeople. The modern tool kit and e-booklets for all the 25 qualifications have also been released on the day of launch.

7.4 Consequent upon the launch of the scheme, the Awarding Body, Handicraft sector skill Council and Beauty and Wellness Sector Skill Council proposed amendments as under:

7.4.1 **Handicraft Sector Skill Council:** The qualification **Traditional Toy maker** has four different skills, namely, **glass toy, leather toy, wooden toy and soft toy**. The modern tool kits being provided for all the four mentioned categories of toy making are going to be different, hence keeping in view that these toys are going to be made specific to the region and there are only 15 hours of upskilling training hence the AB HSSC has proposed to consider each field as a separate qualification.

7.4.2 **Beauty and Wellness Sector Skill Council.** The qualification '**barber (नाई)**' is often related to the qualifications being practiced by the male community, whereas the qualification '**Hairdresser**' would be professed by either men or women. Hence, the request has been received to consider two different qualifications with the names, **barber (नाई) and Hairdresser**.

7.5 The detailed and diligent planning in preparation of the Qualification Files, the content for upskilling on working with the listed modern Tool- kit for all qualifications and various modules of employability skills consisting of Digital Literacy, Financial Literacy, Marketing and Branding and Self-Employment for PM Vishwakarma Scheme is largely attributed to the stakeholders, i.e, all concerned recognized Awarding Bodies (SSCs), NASSCOM, MEPSC, BFSI and RASCI, NSDC, Govt Institutions, Banking Industry like SBI, HDFC, ICICI banks, Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDI), Academic Institutions such as IIM-Indore, NIFT, NID.

## **8. AGENDA ITEM 08: Status Update on development of Modules/ Sub-Modules of Employability Skills/ Life Skills/ Soft Skills**

8.1. National Council for Vocational Education and Training is developing a flexible model of Employability Skills (ES), which will encompass Soft Skills (SS) and Life



Skills (LS) in a dynamic framework. This would address the challenges faced in the implementation of the existing employability skills NOS, which are slightly hardcoded, and do not give the flexibility of choice while selecting various modules for training. The focus is to provide solution to the Awarding Bodies, which gives them flexibility to develop NOS by assembling the required modules/sub-modules as per the industry/job role requirement.

- 8.2. A sub-committee of various organisations like NCVET, MSDE, UNICEF, AICTE, SSCs, and Wadhwani Foundation has been formed to bring the project to fruition. After lot of research and rounds of meetings with the sub-committee, a list of 9 modules and further 47 sub-modules in four variants of NCrf/ NSQF Levels has been finalised. The development of modules and sub-modules is being done in phases. The list of module/sub-modules is indicated in **Annexure I** for reference.
- 8.3. The curriculum for four variants is being developed by organisations such as CII, Media SSC, Management SSC, NASSCOM, Wadhwani Foundation and NIESBUD. The process involved identifying the need of the sub-module for the four variants, developing the Learning Outcomes, Performance Criteria etc. and deriving the Learning Hrs for each sub-module of a module.
- 8.4. Development of the Model curriculum including Learning outcomes, Performance Criteria, Trainer's qualifications/ eligibility/ experience; Assessor's qualifications/ eligibility/ experience; assessment criteria for all the four variants has been completed. The vetting of the same shall be completed by 15<sup>th</sup>, October, 2023. The vetting team includes Subject Matter Experts from organisations like TISS, CII, Banks, SSC's, Universities, Media companies, CDAC etc.
- 8.5. The second part is to develop the content including student's guide; basic resources, Basic e-content based on the model curriculum; Strategy and guidelines for training, and assessment; Training Manual, basic assignments, tutorials; ToT Qualification Assessment Manual, practical assessments methodology; ToA Qualification for all the four variants. Efforts are being made to develop the above mentioned material for Basic and Intermediate Variants by October, 2023 and for Advance and Higher Order Variants by November, 2023.
- 8.6. The employability skills of various modules of 30Hrs, 60Hrs, 90Hrs and 120Hrs were developed by the DGT and approved in the 20<sup>th</sup> NSQC held in June 2022 and further in the 8<sup>th</sup> NCVET Council meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2023. Further, all recognized Awarding bodies were mandated to add these ES NOS, as applicable, in all their

qualifications, existing as well as those being developed for NSQF alignment and approval.

- 8.7. DGT runs the LTT courses in the ITI ecosystem and is currently using the existing NSQF aligned and approved ES NOS. It has been learnt that DGT is currently revising its existing ES NOS, tailor-made for the Learners in the ITI ecosystem. Hence, DGT may continue to use the ES NOS being revised by them. However, as NCVET has undertaken review of the existing ES NOS by developing a flexible model of ES modules and sub-modules to provide required flexibility to the ABs in populating the ES NOS for the VET & skilling qualifications. Once the ES NOS being developed by NCVET is operationalised and implemented, DGT may continue with their own developed ES NOS after approval from NSQC or may use the detailed ES NOS being developed by NCVET for four variants (Basic, Intermediate, Advanced and Higher order employability skills). Since, DGT is also undertaking training on short-term training courses, it has to use the employability skills developed by NCVET as per the guidelines of NCVET for STT.

**10. AGENDA ITEM 10: Adoption of NSQF aligned and NSQC approved Defense Qualifications by various Directorates of Indian Army**

- 10.1 Seventeen (17) Awarding Bodies of Indian Army comprising of fighting arms, support arms and services and two (02) Awarding Bodies one each from Indian Air Force (IAF) and Indian Navy (IN) have been formally affiliated to the skill ecosystem of NCVET through recognition as Awarding Body (Dual Category). Defence Awarding Bodies have mapped their existing qualifications with the various sectors as applicable and have aligned a significant number of their qualifications with NSQF.
- 10.2 In the 31<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the NSQC, it was discussed that a considerable number of NSQF aligned and approved qualifications are common and applicable across Defence Forces with or without minor modifications, therefore Defence Awarding Bodies may adopt such qualifications as per the *NCVET Guidelines for Adoption of Qualifications by Awarding Bodies*. However, for better co-ordination, record keeping, effective execution & implementation, it was decided by the Committee that list of all such qualifications which are being proposed for adoption by the Indian Army Awarding Bodies be sent to **Army Training Command (ARTRAC)** and a consolidated list duly vetted by ARTRAC be submitted before NSQC for grant of approval. Modifications, if required, may also be undertaken in the adopted qualifications subject to adherence to the parameters as per the Guidelines for Adoption of Qualifications.
- 10.3 Subsequently, ARTRAC vide letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> Sep 2023, has shared a list of 102 Qualifications which are proposed for adoption by various Directorates of Indian Army. A brief snapshot the same is as below:
