

**MINUTES OF THE 37<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF NATIONAL SKILLS QUALIFICATIONS  
COMMITTEE (NSQC) HELD ON 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024**

The 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of the National Skills Qualifications Committee (NSQC) was held on 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 through video conferencing, under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Nirmaljeet Singh Kalsi, Chairperson, National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVET). The list of participants is at **Annexure I**. The decisions taken by the Committee, w.r.t agenda items, in the meeting are given in the succeeding paras.

**1. AGENDA ITEM 01: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 36<sup>th</sup> Meeting of NSQC held on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024**

1.1. The Committee was apprised that the Minutes of 36<sup>th</sup> meeting of NSQC were circulated and the following editorial corrections have been received.

1.1.1. The sector name of two qualifications and seven Micro Credentials (MCs) submitted was incorrectly stated as “Energy Sector”. The corrected sector name of the qualifications and MCs is as follows:

**1.1.2.** The nomenclature and entry requirements of one qualification named 'Sr. Product Manager (Aerospace Manufacturing)' submitted by MSME was incorrectly mentioned. The corrected nomenclature and entry requirements are as follows:

**1.2.** The Committee was apprised that the following editorial corrections have been received for the Minutes of 35th meeting of NSQC.

**1.2.1.** 28 revised qualifications of the Tourism and Hospitality Sector Skill Council (THSC) were erroneously listed as "New" and the corrected classification of the same may be read as "**Revised**".

**1.2.2.** NSQF level and Sector of two new qualifications of the Army Air Defence were erroneously mentioned. The corrected NSQF level and Sector of the qualifications are as follows:

**1.2.3.** The Committee was apprised of the decision taken with respect to the range of notional hours for the NSQF alignment and approval of standalone Nano-Credentials (NCs), Micro-Credentials (MCs), and National Occupational Standards (NOSs) that was inadvertently missed out in the minutes of 35th NSQC. The details are as under:

**1.2.4. The Committee confirmed the Minutes of the 35th and 36th meetings of the NSQC along with above corrections.**

## **2. AGENDA ITEM 02: ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE DECISIONS TAKEN IN THE 36<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF NSQC**

**2.1** A detailed account of the **action taken** was presented before the Committee in the Minutes of the 36<sup>th</sup> meeting of NSQC. The Committee acknowledged the action taken and **approved** the same and further emphasized the following:

### **2.1.1. Introducing a system of Re-assessment and fixing the minimum pass percentage for Skill Based Courses in VETS.**

**2.1.1.1.** The Committee was apprised that a system of re-assessment is being introduced for Skill Based Courses in VETS, along with the



fixation of a minimum pass percentage. A meeting was convened on March 27, 2024 for discussion on the matter.

**2.1.1.2. *The Committee directed to also carry out consultations with CBSE, AICTE and UGC and submit the report within two weeks from the date of 37<sup>th</sup> NSQC.***

**2.1.2. Unavailability of Trainee's and Trainer's Handbook for PMKVY 4.0 Qualifications**

**2.1.2.1.** In the 36th meeting of NSQC, the Committee had directed all SSCs to submit Trainee's Handbooks and Trainer's Handbooks for all PMKVY 4.0 qualification within one week from the 36th meeting of NSQC as without them the implementation of PMKVY qualifications would not be possible.

The Committee was apprised about the current status regarding the submission of Trainee's and Trainer's handbook by SSCs.

**2.1.2.2. *The Committee took note of the status and directed the remaining SSCs to make submission of Trainee's and Trainer's Handbooks by 3rd May, 2024.***

**2.1.2.3. *In addition, the Committee stated that all qualifications without corresponding Trainee's and Trainer's Handbooks, shall be archived.***

**2.1.3. Rationalization of Qualifications through Integration of Employability Skills (ES) and Adjustment of Notional Hours to Align with National Credit Framework (NCrF)**

**2.1.3.1. The Committee received a comprehensive update on the status of the rationalized qualifications. 37 ABs have completed the rationalization of the qualifications and 11 ABs have partially completed the rationalization. The number of qualifications overdue for rationalization mentioned in the agenda were 439. However, following NSQC, few of these qualifications have since been rationalized. Consequently, there are now 404**



qualifications slated for rationalization out of which **Haryana State Electronics Development Corporation Limited (HARTRON)** and **Skill Council for Person with Disability (SCPwD)** have informed that they are in the process of submitting 10 and 08 revised qualifications respectively. The details of the same are included as **Annexure II**.

- 2.1.3.2.** *The Committee took note of the status and directed the remaining ABs to complete the submission of rationalized qualifications by 3rd May, 2024, failing which the unratinalised qualifications shall be archived.*
- 2.1.3.3.** *The Committee further stated that Qualifications lacking the provision of “Employability Skills” NOS will also be archived.*

**2.1.4. Submission of incomplete Qualification dockets by the Awarding Bodies (ABs) leading to delay in the approval of the Qualifications**

- 2.1.4.1.** The Committee had directed all Awarding Bodies to provide a comprehensive list of their respective Line Ministries, including contact information for the relevant official/SPOC.
- 2.1.4.2.** The Committee was informed that a communication dated 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2024, was sent to all ABs (Sector Skill Councils) requesting information regarding Line Ministries and the designated officials or SPOCs. Accordingly, details have been received from all Awarding Bodies (Sector Skill Councils). The list is attached as **Annexure III**
- 2.1.4.3.** *The Committee took note of the current status and directed the remaining ABs to expedite the process of submission of the necessary information by 3rd May, 2024.*

**2.1.5. NSQF Levels and the suggested nomenclature for Defence Qualification**



- 2.1.5.1.** The Committee in its 35<sup>th</sup> Meeting had provided comprehensive instructions regarding the usage of nomenclatures in relation to the corresponding NSQF levels and entry requirements for specific qualifications pertaining to Defence ABs and other ABs.
- 2.1.5.2.** The Committee was informed that a communication regarding the submission of revised nomenclature and entry requirements in accordance with NSQC decisions, was disseminated to the Indian Army, Indian Navy, and Indian Air Force and the corrected revised versions of the qualifications were to be submitted within 30 days after the 36th NSQC meeting.
- 2.1.5.3.** Accordingly, a total of 123 qualifications, comprising 66 qualifications with changes in both nomenclature and entry requirements, 44 qualifications with changes only in nomenclature, and 13 qualifications with changes only in entry requirements, have been submitted with revised nomenclature/entry requirements by the seven Directorates of the Indian Army. The details of the Qualifications are provided in **Annexure IV.**
- 2.1.5.4.** *The Committee acknowledged and approved the same.*

**2.1.6. One new and two (02) revised Qualifications of Domestic Workers Sector Skill Council (DWSSC) were presented for NSQC approval**

- 2.1.6.1.** The Committee was apprised that One (01) new and Two (02) revised qualifications of Domestic Workers Sector Skill Council were presented for NSQC approval in the 36th NSQC meeting.
- 2.1.6.2.** The Committee had conditionally approved the qualifications subject to certain changes and submission of the report on the requirement of the House Managers in the market.
- 2.1.6.3.** The Committee was informed that the requisite compliance has been met by the AB.
- 2.1.6.4.** *The Committee acknowledged the same.*



**2.1.7. Nomenclature and Entry criteria for two MCs of Hydrocarbon Sector Skill Council (HSSC)**

**2.1.7.1.** The Committee was apprised that **Hydrocarbon Sector Skill Council** was directed to revise the nomenclature for One (01) MC and the entry criteria for another MC. Accordingly, the AB has submitted the qualifications with the changes and compliance has been met.

**2.1.7.2. *The Committee acknowledged the same.***

**2.1.8. Ten NOSs of NASSCOM presented during the 34th NSQC held on 30th November 2023 for approval**

**2.1.8.1.** The Committee was apprised that Ten (10) NOSs of NASSCOM were presented before the Committee in the 34th NSQC and were conditionally approved subject to the submission of validations from School Boards and Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) where these NOSs are to be implemented.

**2.1.8.2.** Accordingly, the compliance has been met for 6 NOSs and the remaining 4 NOSs have been proposed for withdrawal by the AB which has been allowed. The details of the NOSs are being placed in a separate Agenda no 5.

**2.1.8.3. *The Committee acknowledged the same.***

**3. AGENDA ITEM 03: RATIFICATION OF ONE (01) MICRO CREDENTIAL OF HYDROCARBON SECTOR SKILL COUNCIL (HSSC)**

**3.1.** The Committee was apprised that the training program titled "Workshop on Energy Transition and Green Hydrogen," scheduled to be conducted at the University of Ladakh (UoL) by the Hydrogen and Fuel Cells Sector Skill Council (HSSC), was planned to commence on April 18, 2024.

**3.2.** Keeping in view the urgency to commence the training program, an "on file approval" was accorded by the competent authority vide order no. 15021/03/2019/NCVET dated 09/04/2024. The details of the MC are as follows:

**3.3. The Committee took note and ratified the same.**

**4. AGENDA ITEM 04: RATIFICATION OF FIVE (05) QUALIFICATIONS SUBMITTED BY THE DOMESTIC WORKERS SECTOR SKILL COUNCIL (DWSSC)**

**4.1.** The Committee was apprised of the five (05) qualifications of the DWSSC that are currently being implemented in various training programs in the states of Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh and U.T of Ladakh and had expired in February and March 2024. Also, one of these qualifications named "Caregiver - Person with Disability (Non Clinical)," was archived on the NQR Portal.

**4.2.** DWSSC had requested NCVET to extend the validity of five qualifications till September 30, 2024, and to de-archive the qualification "Caregiver - Person with Disability (Non Clinical)" to ensure uninterrupted ongoing training programs.

**4.3.** An "On file" approval to the Qualifications was accorded by competent authority through order no. 36002/05/2024/NCVET dated April 10, 2024, with the stipulation that no new enrollments will be accepted by the relevant SSC for these specific qualifications during the extended period. The details of the Qualifications are as follows:

**4.4. The Committee took note and ratified the same and suggested the concerned AB to bring revised version of the qualifications if deemed necessary.**

## 5. AGENDA ITEM 05: STATUS OF 10 NOSs CONDITIONALLY APPROVED IN 34TH NSQC HELD ON 30th NOVEMBER 2023

**5.1.** The Committee was apprised that (10) NOSs of NASSCOM (SSC) were presented before the Committee in the 34th NSQC and were conditionally approved subject to the submission of validations from School Boards and Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) where these NOSs were intended to be implemented.

**5.2.** NASSCOM has provided validations for (06) NOSs and has requested the withdrawal of the remaining (04) NOSs as these NOSs are undergoing redesign to align with the standards required for implementation in higher education. The details of the NOSs are as follows:

**5.3. The Committee approved the above agenda.**

**6. AGENDA ITEM 06: INCLUSION OF 70 HOURS ES IN ALL SKILL COURSES FOR PWDs AS WELL AS RECOGNITION AS A STANDALONE NOS BASED CERTIFICATION**

**6.1.** The Committee was informed that during its 20th Meeting on June 30, 2022, the NSQC had instructed all ABs to incorporate appropriate variant (30 Hrs, 60 Hrs, 90 Hrs, or 120 Hrs) of the approved Employability Skills (ES) NOS as a mandatory component in all NSQF aligned and approved qualifications. Accordingly, all the existing NSQF aligned qualifications are being rationalized for inclusion of an appropriate variant of ES NOS.

**6.2.** To customize NSQF aligned and approved qualifications to the specific needs of Persons with Disabilities (PwD), SCPwD has submitted a proposal to consider the inclusion of a 70 Hrs Employability Skill NOS for individuals with Locomotive Disability (LD), Hearing Impairment (HI), and Visual Impairment (VI) while maintaining the core components of the original 60 Hrs ES NOS developed by NCVET. The SCPwD has developed 70 Hrs Employability Skill NOS in consultation with the Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwDs) and Enable India (a Civil Society Organization dedicated to the empowerment of PwDs).

**6.3.** Further, DEPwD vide its letter SK/2/2023-Skill dated April 9, 2024, advised SCPwD to incorporate the customized 70-hour ES Module instead of the existing 60 Hrs ES Module in all NSQF aligned and approved qualifications developed



for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) to cater to their specific expository based requirement and ensuring better outreach and accessibility. It was further emphasized that the total credits awarded to this NOS would remain the same as that of a 60 Hrs NOS, as the additional hours would cater to the pedagogical and assistive requirements of PwD learners.

**6.4.** In addition, the Committee decided that any student or learner with disabilities (PwD) can also take up additional Employability Skills National Occupational Standards (ES NOSs) or Micro-Credential (MCs) which are being developed by the NCVET, comprising of nine modules and fifty sub-modules.

**6.5. *The Committee approved the 70 Hrs ES NOS as a standalone NOS and approved inclusion of the 70 Hrs ES NOS in all qualifications pertaining to PwD.***

**7. AGENDA ITEM 07: RATIFICATION OF ADOPTION OF NSQF ALIGNED AND APPROVED QUALIFICATIONS BY DIRECTORATE OF JAN SIKSHAN SANSTHAN (DJSS)**

**7.1.** The DJSS was recognized as an Awarding Body (dual category) with Pan India Jurisdiction on 7th February, 2023 and has till date developed 15 qualifications that are NSQF aligned and approved. DJSS has submitted a request for the adoption of 13 pre-existing NSQF aligned and approved qualifications developed by various Awarding Bodies.

**7.2.** These 13 qualifications were examined in accordance with the provisions outlined in the 'Guidelines for Adoption of Qualifications by Awarding Bodies. It was noted that the proposed versions of qualifications for adoption have been modified in terms of notional hours and eligibility criteria, to ensure alignment with the National Credit Framework (NCrF) and the revised NSQF notification.

**7.3.** Consequently, the DJSS has been granted the awarding rights for the qualifications listed below through 'on-file' approval vide order dated 8th April, 2024. DJSS has been instructed to ensure that the trainings are conducted in accordance with the latest available version of these qualifications. The details of latest versions of the qualifications tabled for adoption by DJSS are as follows:

**7.4. The Committee ratified the above agenda.**

**7.5. The Committee further directed that any Awarding Body, upon selecting qualifications for adoption should first approach the Developer Body regarding the said qualification, obtain mutual consent and submit the same along with the application for adoption in accordance with the implementation mechanism prescribed in Guidelines for Adoption of Qualifications by Awarding Bodies.**

**8. AGENDA ITEM 08: ADOPTION OF NSQF ALIGNED AND APPROVED QUALIFICATIONS BY INDIAN ARMY**

- 8.1.** The Committee was informed that in the 31st Meeting of NSQC a significant number of qualifications that have been approved and aligned with the NSQF are applicable across Defence Forces with or without minor modifications. As such, Defence Awarding Bodies may adopt these qualifications in accordance with the NCVET Guidelines for Adoption of Qualifications by Awarding Bodies.
- 8.2.** Accordingly, the Committee had decided that in order to improve coordination, documentation, efficient execution, and implementation, a consolidated list of qualifications proposed for adoption by the Indian Army Awarding Bodies and duly vetted by ARTRAC should be presented to the NSQC for approval. Further, modifications if required may be undertaken in the adopted qualifications subject to adherence to the parameters as per the Guidelines of Adoption of Qualifications.



**8.3.** Subsequently, ARTRAC has shared a list of 17 qualifications proposed for adoption by 06 Directorates of Indian Army (Awarding Bodies). The details of the qualifications are placed at **Annexure V** .

**8.4. The Committee duly noted and approved the agenda**

**9. AGENDA ITEM 09: SUBMISSION OF QUALIFICATIONS FOR NSQF ALIGNMENT & APPROVAL**

**9.1** A total of **205 (122 New and 59 Revised) qualifications, 10 NOSs and 14 Micro-Credentials** were received at NCVET and **191 qualifications (115 New Qualifications, 59 Revised Qualifications, 10 NOSs and 7 Micro-Credentials)** were placed in this NSQC for approval. The detailed status of approval and decision of the Committee is placed at **Annexure VI (Qualifications from Defence Forces) and Annexure VII (Qualifications from Central Ministries/State Bodies/SSCs/Other Govt. & Pvt. Bodies)**.

**9.2** The detailed status of the Qualifications received is in the succeeding paras:

**9.2.1. NSQF alignment and approval of Qualifications submitted by Indian Defence Forces**

**9.2.1.1. Corps of Electronics and Mechanical Engineers:** One (01) new Qualification was presented before the Committee and **was approved**.

**9.2.1.2. Directorate General of Artillery:** Four (04) new Qualifications were presented before the Committee and **were approved**.

**9.2.1.3. Indian Air Force:** Two (02) new Qualifications and Six (06) revised Qualifications were presented before the Committee and **were approved**.

**10.1.2.1.** The 6 NOSs have been developed as part of the current Indo-Australian partnership in skilling and education for which regular review meetings are being held between Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, India and Dept. of Education, Skills, and Employment, Australia.

**10.1.2.2.** Further, these 6 NOSs are also part of the 20 job roles under the “*Developing Critical Agricultural Skills Project*” funded by the Australian Federal Government, Department of Education to strengthen India’s agriculture sector and led by University of Adelaide in collaboration with Skills Impact, Central Queensland University, the National Skills Foundation of India and the ASCI.


